### **Japan's Nuclear Liability System – Law, Practice and Lessons from Enforcement in connection with the Fukushima Nuclear Accident**

Mr. Hokugo has served *inter alia* in the Task Force for the Reform of Nuclear Regulations and Organisations at the Cabinet Secretariat (2012–2013) and as Deputy Director of the Atomic Energy Policy Division of MEXT (2009–2008). He has worked intensively on issues of compensation for nuclear damage both with regard to the JCO's Criticality Accident of 1999 and the Fukushima Nuclear Accident of 2011. He has been among the drafters of the amendment to the Nuclear Liability Compensation Act in 2009 and the guidelines of the Dispute Reconciliation Committee for Nuclear Damage.
